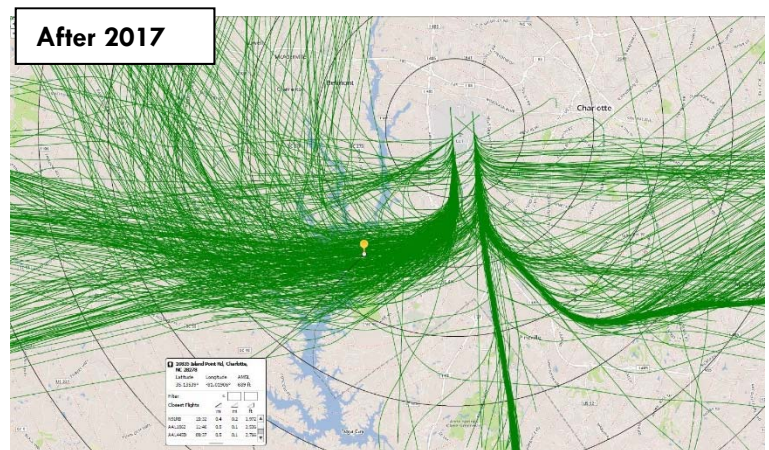
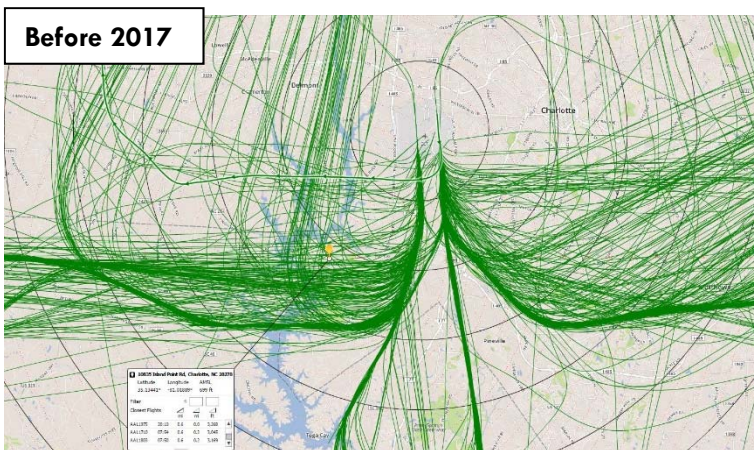
- **Why** you are being subjected to airport noise and emissions
- **How** it may affect your health and property
- **What** you can do to express your concern and dissatisfaction

In 2017, the FAA fully implemented new procedures (NextGen Multiplex) at Charlotte's airport allowing arrivals and departures to **take shorter routes at lower altitudes** over populated neighborhoods. Departures and arrivals are now **frequently as low as 3,000 feet** over residential areas.

The FAA's stated goals are "repeatable and predictable flight paths" and earlier divergence on departures." **Residents are told, however, that nothing has changed**, it's the weather, and/or air traffic is being "dispersed."

A review of pre and post 2017 air traffic shows a shift of departures over residential areas instead of gaining altitudes over commercial and industrial zoned areas before turning.

City Council was never formally consulted about these changes.
